 The restaurant name is Pettan-kun.

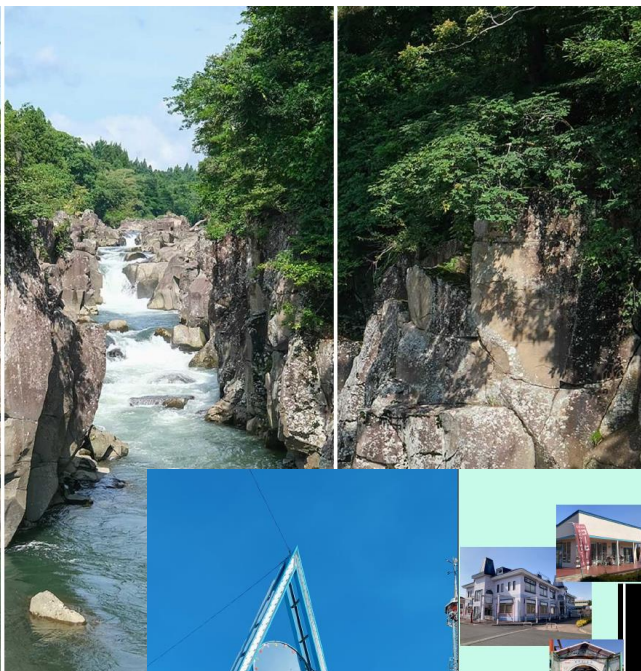
## Ichinoseki Museum
